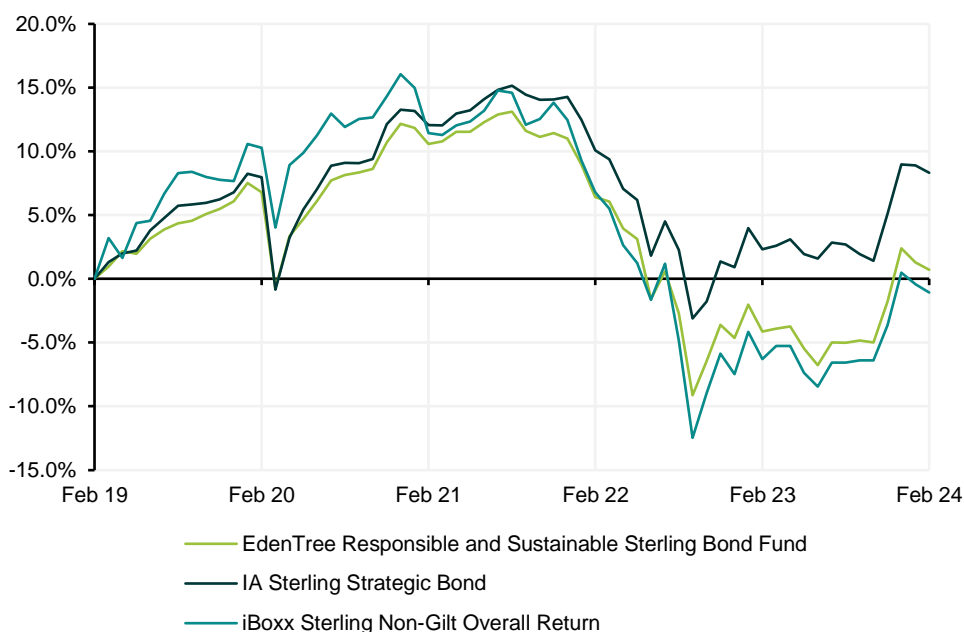

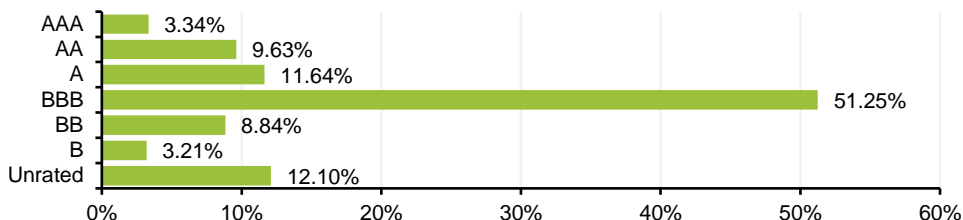

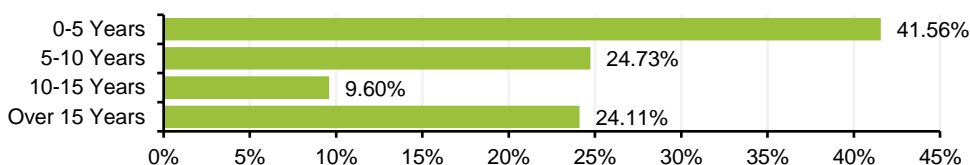

Bond Maturity



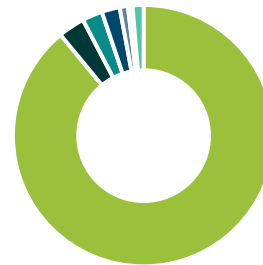
